Dear Re-Admitted Student:

Welcome back to Wentworth Institute of Technology! This is an update and a reminder that you are required to participate in the laptop computer distribution program. At the distribution, you will be given your laptop and be guided through the initial steps essential for you to properly utilize your new laptop. Please **bring your Wentworth student identification card** with you when you come to pick up your laptop.

All readmitted students can receive their laptops from 8:30AM to 3:00PM, beginning on Monday, January 9, 2012, through Friday, January 13, 2012, at the DTS Help Desk, Beatty Hall, Room 320. Depending upon availability, and on your academic major and class year status, you will receive either a Lenovo or Apple MacBookPro laptop matching your classmates.

Caution: It is the responsibility of all readmitted students to make sure that financial holds (especially holds for not returning laptops when you separated from Wentworth) are cleared before coming to the DTS Help Desk. We cannot issue you a laptop until financial holds are cleared by Student Financial Services. If you are unsure of your status, please check with Student Financial Services before coming to the Help Desk.

After Friday, January 13, 2012, you will need to make an appointment to pick up your laptop by calling the [Division of Technology Services Help Desk](#) at ext. 4500. When calling the Help Desk, identify yourself as a new student who missed the January 2012 Laptop Distribution.

If you do not contact the Help Desk and make arrangements to pick up your new laptop by the close of business on Friday, January 20, 2012, a hold may be placed on your account to prevent you from registering for classes or viewing grades online in the future. You will then need a form from the Student Service Center to present to the DTS Help Desk in order to pick up your new laptop.

Please note: All new students will receive a [Targus laptop backpack carrying case](#) that will accommodate either a Lenovo or Apple laptop. You will also receive a network cable as part of your initial setup.
