
Jumbled Sentence Questions

With this question type, students are presented with a portion of a sentence and dropdown lists from which they must select the words that are missing from the sentence and put them in the correct order.

Example: Translate the following sentence into French: I love to work at Wentworth!
J'[aime][travailler] [avec] [Wentworth]!

Note: The text that appears in square brackets is replaced by dropdown lists, which display the text in random order.

- If you want to create an additional alternate answer, click **Create Alternate**. The **Answers** section updates to display the alternate answer fixed text and dropdown lists containing the jumbled text.
- If you want to remove an alternate answer, under the alternate answer you want to remove, click **Remove Alternate**.

The **Answers** section updates and the alternate answer is removed.
